How to store sharps

- ✓ A strong plastic container with a screw top cap



- ✓ An Australian Standard Sharps container



What not to use for sharps

- ✗ Glass and cardboard are **NOT** safe



- ✗ Tins are **NOT** safe



- ✗ Plastic soft-drink/water bottles are **NOT** safe



Where to dispose of your sharps

Place sharps in an appropriate container.

- ✗ Do not dispose in the bin

- ✓ Participating pharmacies



- ✓ Local Councils
